STUDY ABROAD & INTERNATIONAL SCHOLARSHIPS

The Office of International Programs' (OIP) mission is to promote and develop a wide range of international and educational opportunities through the establishment of strategic partnerships with top ranked academic institutions and organizations. This enables GUST students and faculty to integrate into the emerging global knowledge and learning network.

The OIP administers the following programs:

- Student Summer Scholarship
- Faculty Summer Fellowship
- Graduate Scholarship Mission

In 2013, the Foundation Program Unit at GUST was granted the Commission on Intensive English Program Accreditation (CEA) for its English Foundation Program. In 2014, GUST became the first private university in Kuwait to receive the AACSB-International accreditation for its College of Business Administration, and the Accreditation Board for Engineering and Technology (ABET) for its Computer Science program. Most recently, GUST's Mass Communication and Media Department was awarded full accreditation by the American Communication Association (ACA).

GUST-UMSL 2+2 PROGRAM

Our GUST-UMSL 2+2 program enables students to begin their undergraduate degree program at GUST, and complete it at the University of Missouri – St. Louis (UMSL) in one of the many degree programs not currently available at GUST. Since 2006, 13 students have completed the 2+2 program.

During the first part of the 2+2 program, students must complete their first two years of general education requirements at GUST. Upon completion of their sophomore year, 2+2 students transfer to UMSL to complete their upper-division degree requirements. Subject to degree and major requirements, most general education credits earned at GUST are transferable toward a degree at UMSL. Upon completion of the remaining degree requirements at UMSL, 2+2 students will earn a degree issued by the University of Missouri–St. Louis.

This program is ideal for students desiring an international experience and the opportunity to take courses in the United States without the commitment of living abroad for four years. It is also suitable for students wishing to specialize in one of the many additional degree programs offered at UMSL.



SUMMER SCHOLARSHIP

Each year, GUST offers its students a limited number of competitive summer scholarships to enrich their academic experience through international study. GUST's summer scholarships are open to all students from both the College of Arts & Sciences and the College of Business Administration that fulfill the eligibility requirements. The scholarships include tuition for six academic credit hours, a round trip economy class ticket to the United States, and a support allowance.

Since 2006, a total of 105 students were granted a Summer Scholarship to attend the University of Missouri – St. Louis, George Washington University, Florida International University, and University of Dubai.



The GUST Graduate Scholarship Mission comes as a valuable part of GUST's strategic faculty hiring process, in order to integrate its graduates as faculty members. Candidates are offered a fully-funded Masters and PhD scholarship inclusive of tuition fees and a monthly stipend. Scholarship recipients are expected to study at one of the QS top 100 universities worldwide, pre-approved by GUST. These universities are endorsed by the Ministry of Higher Education and the Kuwait Cultural Office in the study country. Upon completion of their postgraduate studies, they will serve as GUST faculty member for the same number of years they spent abroad.



SUMMER FACULTY FELLOWSHIP

GUST provides a limited number of faculty fellowships for research and development during the summer. They are available to all GUST faculty on an equal opportunity basis.

Since 2006, a total of 63 faculty members were granted fellowships to conduct collaborative research projects with their peer researchers; 45 to the University of Missouri - St. Louis, 11 to Florida International University, two to the University of Massachusetts-Lowell, and one to each of Cambridge University, Oxford University, Derby University, London School of Economics, and the University of Queensland.

OXADVENTURE

In partnership with OXadventure, a local non-profit organization established by young Kuwaitis in 2013, the Mass Communication and Media Department at GUST, conduct annual aid-work internship trips. OXadventure aims to educate the younger generation about global citizenship by donating their time and energy to affected communities. Throughout the trips, students also take the time to explore and appreciate the country's people, culture, and beauty. In 2014, students had the opportunity to help build an orphanage for a community in Bangalore, India; a community center with a computer-training lab in Sri Lanka, in 2015; renovated a school in Kathmandu, Nepal, in 2016; and built a library in Hoi An, Vietnam, in 2017.

Most recently, a trip to the Tetouan Province in Tangier, Morocco took place in 2018. The team volunteered on a 10-day project focused on providing sustainable education and improving living standards for at-risk children in the area.
